COLORGUARD/WINTERGUARD

WHAT IS COLORGUARD?

A special performing group that enhances the visual and thematic aspects of the marching production while performing with equipment (flags, rifles, sabers, etc.).

WHAT IS WINTERGUARD?

A special performing group that competes in the North Texas Colorguard Assoc. and the Caprock Color Guard Circuit. Shows are held indoors (gym) and guards perform to recorded music while performing with equipment (flags, rifles, sabers, etc.).

DO I HAVE TO BE IN BAND?

NO! All students outside of band are eligible to audition. Anyone who has a desire to perform and be part of a state competitive organization may audition.

IS THIS A CLASS AT HIGH SCHOOL?

YES! Known as “Guard Techniques”, the colorguard/winterguard class is offered in both the fall & spring semesters. This class will help you to learn body movement, show details, and perfect equipment skills & technique. We’re excited this discipline is offered as a class during the school day!

COST & TIME:

Performance/practice equipment, transportation, etc. – covered by the school
Uniforms, personal equipment (if desired) – covered by students
There is a \$100 guard membership fee to participate.

Each guard member is an integral part of the entire performing ensemble (band, guard, percussion, dance, etc.) This is a performance-based class, therefore, all members are required to attend all rehearsals and performances each semester. The organization meets on an after-school schedule for rehearsals and, of course, performs at all football games, contests, parades, etc.
